AT YOUR DOORSTEP - BALE



Tucked away between Rovinj and Pula, the hilltop town of Bale is a poetic mosaic of ancient stone alleys, quiet courtyards, and ivy-clad facades. A place where time seems to slow, Bale's charm lies not in grandeur but in its beautifully weathered simplicity. Built on Roman foundations and lovingly preserved through centuries, it exudes a quiet elegance that has long drawn artists, musicians, and dreamers. With its summer jazz festival, inviting art galleries, and rich cultural calendar, Bale offers more than just a postcard-perfect setting - it offers a soul-soothing experience far from the crowds.

Bembo Palace – A 15th-century noble residence that anchors the town's stone-clad main square, blending Gothic, Renaissance, and Venetian influences.

Church of St. Julian – Dominating the village with its elegant bell tower, this church is a peaceful spot for reflection and a focal point of local life.

Ulika Gallery & Local Studios – Small yet spirited art spaces showcasing contemporary Istrian creativity in sculpture, painting, and design.

Dinosaur Fossils Site (Colone Bay) – Just outside the town, along the coast, lies a fascinating discovery site of dinosaur bones embedded in ancient rock.

Boulevard of World Geniuses – A quiet street just outside Bale, on the way to Meneghetti, lined with bronze plaques celebrating the world's greatest minds, from Da Vinci and Mozart to Tesla and Einstein.

Boutique galleries, ateliers and bars - Bale's charming streets are dotted with intimate art spaces and lively bars, perfect for discovering local creativity and enjoying a relaxed evening atmosphere.

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AT YOUR DOORSTEP - THE FORTS



Near Meneghetti, these Austro-Hungarian forts stand as historic sentinels along Istria's coast. Perfect for cycling tours, they offer a fascinating glimpse into the past amid stunning vineyard and sea views.

Old Fort Barbariga – A Venetian-era fortress overlooking the sea near Barbariga Bay, offering panoramic views and a glimpse into coastal defence strategies. Built in the 17th century, it was part of Venice's network to guard against Ottoman and pirate incursions.

Fort Benedetto – Located close to the Meneghetti estate, this 19th-century fortification features robust stone walls and commanding views of the surrounding countryside. Constructed by the Austro-Hungarian Empire, it served as a key stronghold during their rule over Istria.

Fort Paravia West – One of the coastal forts guarding the western approaches, known for its strategic position and preserved military architecture. Erected in the late 19th century, it was designed to protect vital maritime routes along the Adriatic coast.

Fort Paravia Untertritt – Situated near Fort Paravia West, this smaller outpost once served as an essential lookout point along the coast. It was built as part of the Austro-Hungarian defensive system to monitor naval movements and signal threats.

Caluzzi Battery – A well-preserved artillery battery, historically part of the coastal defence network, offering insights into Istria's military history. Established in the late 1800s, it was equipped to fend off naval attacks during times of regional conflict.

Fort Forno – Perched on a rugged coastal promontory, Fort Forno stands as a striking reminder of Istria's layered past, with stunning views across the Adriatic. Originally constructed by the Venetians in the 17th century, it guarded strategic sea routes and local settlements.

PULA



Charming and steeped in centuries of captivating history, Pula sits proudly at the southern tip of the Istrian peninsula. Celebrated for its remarkably preserved Roman architecture and warm, welcoming spirit, the city offers a rich tapestry of culture, nature, and seaside splendour. From ancient arenas to sun-kissed beaches, Pula is a destination that lingers in the heart long after the journey ends — a must-see for those seeking both depth and beauty on their Istrian escape.

Pula Arena - One of the best-preserved Roman amphitheatres in the world, this 2,000-year-old marvel still echoes with the grandeur of ancient spectacles.

Pula Kastel - A 17th-century Venetian fortress crowning the city, now home to the Historical Museum of Istria, offering sweeping views and rich heritage.

Zerostrasse - Beneath the Kastel lies a network of mysterious WWI-era tunnels, once a shelter, now an atmospheric underground journey through history.

Pula Forum -The city's main square since Roman times, flanked by striking ancient ruins including the Temple of Augustus, dedicated to the first Roman emperor.

Arch of the Sergii - A triumphal Roman arch from the 1st century BC, once a city gate. A popular photo spot, especially striking when lit up in the evening.

Twin Gates & City Walls - Remnants of Pula's ancient fortifications, offering a glimpse into its defensive history.

Chapel of St. Maria Formosa - A hidden gem from the 6th century, showcasing early Christian mosaics and Byzantine influence.

The Cathedral of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary - A serene place of worship with origins dating back to Roman times, rebuilt over centuries into a fascinating blend of styles.

POREČ

HISTORICAL TOWNS OF HUM, BUZET AND BUJE







Perched on a hilltop above the source of the Mirna River, **Hum**, with just 30 inhabitants, is often called the smallest town in the world. Legend has it that Hum was built from the stones left over by giants after they constructed other towns in the Mirna River valley. Must see: Church of the Assumption of Mary; Humskakonoba; Raboš Wine Bar; Aura Museum

Nestled in the valley of the Mirna river, in a region known as Buzeština, the hilltop town of **Buzet** offers a picturesque view of the fertile landscape nourished by the longest river in Istria, the Mirna. Buzet is renowned as the 'City of Truffles,' with the forests along the Mirna River being particularly rich in these prized culinary delights. Must see: Truffle museum; Family destilery Aura; Tartufi shops (Pietro&Pietro (Natura tartufi), Zigante tartufi

The enchanting town of **Buje** in Croatia is located in the hinterland of Istria, about 13 kilometers from the resorts of Umag and Novigrad. Surrounded by beautiful hilly countryside, vineyards,, Buje is a true gem on the Istrian peninsula and a popular excursion destination. Notable attractions include the medieval old town, once a fortress, and the historic churches in the center. Must see: Old town; Church of St. Servul; Church of St. Mary of Mercy


